Description: Updated the tax exempt status of an order changing based on Avalara communicating whether an order is exempt or not exempt.

- Reserved Inventory Hold Time

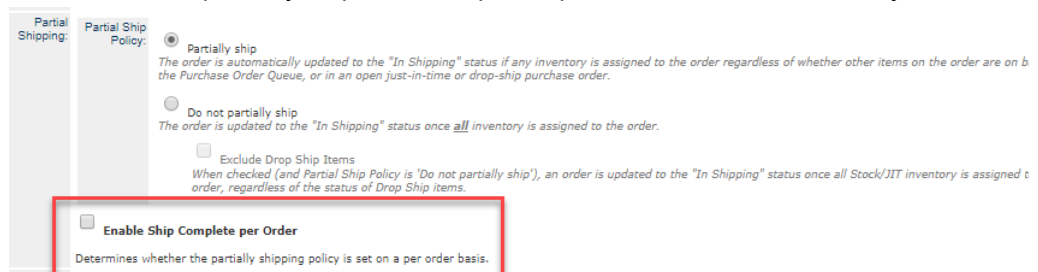
Enhancement: **PS-5512: Ship Complete Setting**

System Path: System Settings > Order Lifecycle > Automation

Description: Added a 'Ship Complete' feature that enables users to override the setting in Order Life Cycle Manager>Automation>Partial Shipping /Partial Ship Policy. The field is enabled through a new setting 'Enable Ship Complete per Order.' This setting allows the user to override the Partial Ship Policy on a per order basis. If the Partial Ship Policy is set to:

- 'Partially ship' then 'Ship Complete' will be defaulted to "no".
- 'Do not partially ship' then 'Ship Complete' will be defaulted to "yes".

Description: Added GET & PUT WebData API Endpoints.

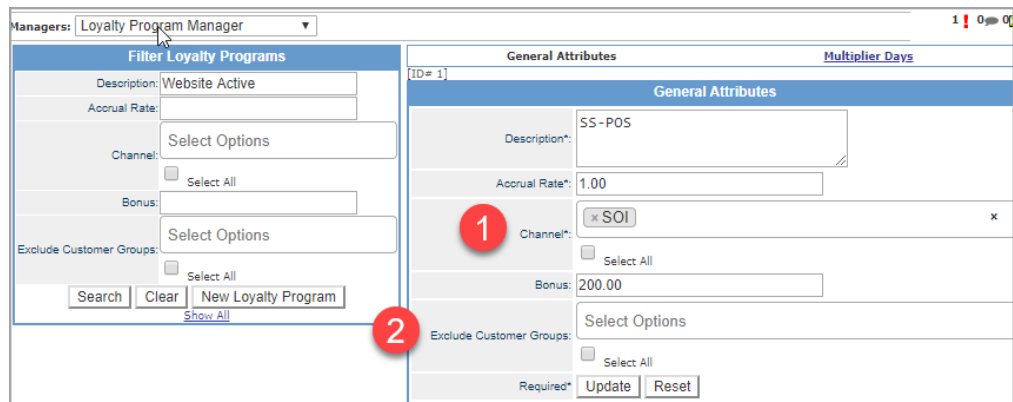
Enhancement: PS-5508, 5507: Loyalty Program Manager Updates

Description: Added the ability to create loyalty programs that work across multiple channels. Customers can earn points if they make purchase in any designated channels. Also added the ability to exclude customers groups from enrolling or being enrolled in a loyalty program.

2. Added the ability to exclude customer groups.




Enhancement: PS-5505: Tax Exemption Expiration Date

Version: 7.4

System Path: Customer Manager > Tax Exempt

Description: Added 'Expiration Date' to Tax Exempt Certificates. It can be set via the Customer Manager > Tax Exempt tab. The tax exempt certificate is not available to be applied or applied automatically if expired, regardless if the certificate is active and/or automatic.

Bug #	Description
BUG-17092	Updated the Shipment Manager to fail gracefully with large queries.
BUG-17091	Updated PO Assignments > 'x' icon (delete action) to only be available to delete if there are no receivers on the PO and to delete the row (instead of marking it as voided) if clicked.
BUG-17075	Updated two of the scenarios for BOGOs. It was checking whether the Buy & Get and Buy products was greater than or equal to the Buy & Get amounts and was incorrectly subtracting the Get from Buy & Get as opposed to using as much of the Get quantity for the Get amount and then only subtracting that amount from Buy & Get if any was needed to be used for the get amount from Buy & Get.
